## NOTE FOR THE ATTENTION OF MEMBERS OF THE ELECTRONIC CUSTOMS COORDINATION GROUP AND THE CUSTOMS CODE COMMITTEE – GENERAL CUSTOMS LEGISLATION SECTION

Subject: Information about granting derogation decisions regarding ICS2
Release 3 for road and rail traffic

As a result of the Commission Information note "Initial information about granting derogation decisions regarding ICS2 Release 3 and NCTS-P6 implementation" of 1 August 2025, several Member States, as well as the UK in respect of Northern Ireland, submitted requests for derogations under Article 6(4) of the Union Customs Code, regarding ICS2 Release 3 and NCTS-P6 for goods entering by road and rail means of transport.

Having carefully considered these requests, DG TAXUD intends to advise the European Commission in favour of granting a **derogation for ICS2 Release 3 for road and rail traffic**, with retroactive effect from 1 September 2025:

- Until 31 December 2025 for goods entering the Union customs territory through Ireland, Spain, France, Italy, Lithuania, Hungary, Finland, Greece and the United Kingdom in respect of Northern Ireland and potentially Bulgaria (1); until that date, the entry summary declarations (ENS) may be lodged in ICS1 or in ICS2.
- Until 1 June 2026 for goods entering the Union customs territory through Croatia, Latvia, Poland, Romania and Slovakia; these Member States will develop the additional and voluntary interconnection between the ICS2 and NCTS systems (optin Member States). Until that date, the entry summary declarations (ENS) may be lodged in ICS1, in ICS2 or, where applicable, in combination with the transit declaration in NCTS-P5.

By contrast, from 1 September 2025,

✓ goods entering the Union customs territory through Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Portugal, Slovenia and Sweden must be covered by an ENS filed in ICS2;

- ✓ goods in **postal consignments** entering the Union customs territory through **Bulgaria**, **Croatia**, **Estonia**, **Latvia**, **Poland**, **Romania** and **Slovakia** and must be covered by an ENS filed in ICS2;
- ✓ other goods entering the Union customs territory through **Estonia** and in principle **Bulgaria** (¹) must be covered by an ENS lodged in ICS2 or, where applicable, lodged in combination with the transit declaration in **NCTS-P6**.

The derogation decisions are currently going through the internal adoption processes and will be subject to the advisory procedure in the Customs Code Committee – General Legislation Section in September 2025. Further information on this, and in relation to an NCTS-P6 derogation, will follow in due course.
